Town Board Meeting

Monday April 14, 2014

Chairman Steigerwaldt called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

Following the pledge of allegiance – roll call of officers was taken. Chairman Bob Steigerwaldt, Supervisors Rick Nieman & Jay Dick, Clerk Andrea Michaud and Treasurer Julie Allen were present

There was a Steigerwaldt/Nieman motion to adopt the agenda with the changes as noted (moved item #6 and #7 to end of agenda just before the public comments) All ayes. Motion passed

The Treasurer's report for March 2014 shows \$223,350.80 and balanced with the clerk. There was a Steigerwaldt/ Nieman motion to enter the treasurer's report into the record. All ayes

Motion passed

Todd Jelinek was present to find out what the Town Board has decided about making Northforest Road a town road. After discussion there was a Steigerwaldt/Nieman motion that the town chair send all documents to Attorney Harrold to review and provide an opinion to the board. All ayes Motion passed

At this time the board does not need to go into closed session regarding employment. They will wait for the rest of applications to come in. The board will then meet to go over all the applications. The board also discussed Ron Miller working for the town and going over the roads with Gary. There was a Steigerwaldt/Nieman motion to utilize Ron Miller for up to a month as authorized by Gary. All ayes Motion passed.

Rick Nieman will review the recycling bills and the fuel surcharge from Advance Disposal.

Rick Nieman will be working on website with Dave Long and will get back to the board.

Steigerwaldt advised the board that they still need at least 3 alternates for the board of review.

Steigerwaldt has the new locks and keys for the hall and garage.

Steigerwaldt discussed the proposed 2014 town road projects. He advised the board that Rod Akey is behind because of the frost so he is waiting for a quote on West Shady Shore. Pickerel Creek Road has a lot of pot holes which are being filled for now. Steigerwaldt gave Supervisors Dick and Nieman a list of road projects to look over. He discussed several of the roads and what work needs to be done.

Steigerwaldt sent in for the training manual on liquor licensing and will be studying that.

Steigerwaldt has a liquor license ordinance that Attorney Burgy drafted and will get a copy to Supervisors Dick and Nieman. The clerk will try to use the template that the City of Tomahawk uses for the operator's license. The board will review the operator's licenses before the June 30, 2014 expiration. There was a Steigerwaldt/Dick motion to put the liquor and operators licenses on the May agenda.

Steigerwaldt discussed the fire calls and that the board should be receiving copies of the quarterly reports and incident reports. The clerk advised the board that copies of the quarterly reports were sent to the board members.

Steigerwaldt would like the board to get a monthly report of all the deposits that come in each month presented like they are on the annual reports. The clerk will give the board a monthly report of all deposits.

The clerk advised the board that the assessor has May 17, 2014 for open book and June 7, 2014 for board of review. Supervisor Dick advised that he will not be available on June 7th. The clerk will check with Cindy Chase to see what other dates she has for board of review and will get back to the board.

The weight limits are now on the roads and permits are required.

Steigerwaldt called Attorney Burgy for the individual hours on the driveway ordinance. The treasurer will print out a report for Steigerwaldt on the payments received from Holly Lund.

The clerk gave Steigerwaldt a copy of the 2 bills the town received from Dennis Burgy.

Steigerwaldt discussed the town board agenda's. There was a question about an open meeting agenda that did not have a specific agenda item regarding an audit. Last month Julie said she felt the chair's posting of the meeting was wrong. The WTA attorney and Attorney Harrold discussed this together and felt there was no violation of law.

There was a Steigerwaldt/Nieman motion to have the clerk verify that all the ordinances have been published according to the law. All ayes Motion passed.

Steigerwaldt would like a copy of the taped minutes from January 2014 to March 2014. The clerk will get a copy of the taped minutes to Steigerwaldt.

There was a Steigerwaldt/Dick motion to approve the vouchers. All ayes, Motion passed.

At 9:25 there was a Steigerwaldt/Nieman motion to adjourn. All ayes Motion passed.
