

APPROVED MINUTES

Town of King
Town Board Meeting

Monday July 14 2014

Supervisor Jay Dick called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

Following the pledge of allegiance – roll call of officers was taken. Supervisors Rick Nieman & Jay Dick, and Clerk Andrea Michaud were present. Chairman Bob Steigerwaldt and Treasurer Julie Allen were absent.

There was a Nieman /Dick motion to approve the agenda as printed All ayes. Motion passed

There was a Dick/Nieman motion to approve all the vouchers. All ayes Motion passed.

The Treasurer's report for June 2014 will be presented at the August board meeting.

Fire calls: refund Fox will be moved to August meeting.

The board discussed the property & health complaint. The resident was present at the meeting and advised the board they he is in the process of cleaning up the property. After further discussion this will be tabled to next month.

Supervisor Nieman advised he will look into getting quotes for mowing next year.

Todd Jelinek was present and asked the board if they heard from Attorney Harrold regarding the letter Todd Jelinek's attorney sent.

Supervisor Dick will contact Attorney Harrold to get a copy of the letter.

Supervisor Nieman will set up a date and time for the clerk and him to get together with David Long to set up the website.

Glenn Mott the president of Lake Alice Association advised the town board that the town's boat landings are in bad shape. There is erosion, planks are bad, some landings have holes that are at least 18in deep. Jerry Jagmin advised the board that he has ordered 24 planks and should have early next week. They are working on the boat landings to get them in shape. Glenn Mott suggested that maybe the town and the lake association could form a committee for the boat landings. He asked about having docks at all the boat landings. The board will have to check the state statutes and what is the town's responsibility.

Shari Wendland presented the conditional use permit to the town board to continue to keep 2 horses that they own. After discussing and reviewing the conditional use permit there was a Dick/Nieman motion to approve the conditional use permit with no recommendations. All ayes Motion passed.

The board reviewed the liquor license for the new owners of Riversedge and the operators licenses for Greg Jonas, LeAnne Jonas, Eric Haring, Hayley Rieuf, James Becker and Brenda Becker. There was a Dick/Nieman motion to approve the liquor license and the operators licenses except for James Becker and Brenda Becker. All ayes Motion passed. The clerk will contact James Becker and Brenda Becker about the beverage responsibility course.

Supervisor Nieman asked the clerk about charges for copies and tapes. The clerk gave him a copy of prior billing for copies and tapes along with a copy of the minutes from the February 9, 2009 board meeting .He will pass this information to Bob Steigerwaldt

Supervisor Nieman asked Jerry Jagmin if he had a chance to meet with Bob about the roads. Jerry Jagmin has not had a chance to meet with Bob. He advised the board that the grader is down and that as soon as it is working he will be grading Spring Creek & Lilly Lake Road area. He did indicate that if the town has any TRIP money by the August town board meeting that they should get estimates on what it would cost to do Pine Shore Lane which is the TRIP project.

The clerk did receive an application and resume for the grader/operator position and gave copies to Supervisor Dick and Supervisor Nieman.

The town board and the clerk received a letter from the residents regarding Spring Creek ATV's. Bob Steigerwaldt will draft a letter and will show the board a copy of the letter before it sends it.

Glenn Mott did make a public comment on behalf of a town resident about the Wendland conditional use permit. The resident was concerned about the horse, excavating and load noises from the area. Supervisor Dick advised that the resident should file a complaint through Lincoln County. Another resident asked about some work being done on Shady Shore West. Supervisor Nieman indicated that they would not be able to answer his questions at this time without discussing with Bob Steigerwaldt.

There was a Dick/Nieman motion to approve the Town Board Minutes from February, March, April, May and June of 2014. All ayes, Motion passed.

There was a Dick/Nieman motion to table the approval of the minutes from the closed meetings of May 20, 2013, July 17, 2013, February 5, 2014 and February 25, 2014. All ayes Motion passed. The clerk will give copies of these minutes to Supervisors Dick and Nieman.

At 8:00 pm. There was a Dick/Nieman motion to adjourn. All ayes Motion passed.
