Town Board Meeting

Approved Minutes

Monday November 9, 2015

-Chairman Wiese called the meeting to order at 7:25pm following the Public Budget Meetings at 7:00pm  
-Roll call of officers was taken. Chairman Wiese, Supervisors Steigerwaldt & Tomaszewski, Treasurer Julie Allen and Clerk Donna Edwards were present.

-There was a Wiese/Steigerwaldt motion to approve the agenda with one change. Move item 4 from new business to next. All ayes. Motion passed.

There was a Steigerwaldt/Wiese motion to accept 2016 Highway Expenditure as approved by the electors. All ayes. Motion carried.

There was a Steigerwaldt/Wiese motion to adopt the 2015 Town Tax Levy to be paid in 2016 as approved by the electors. All ayes. Motion carried.

- First Public Forum-brief concerns Resident R. Dornbrack, stated his concern with the grade on South Pine Road. The board agreed to look into the concern, and call a contractor in as needed.

There was a Tomaszewski/Steigerwaldt motion to approve all the vouchers. All ayes Motion carried.

The Treasurer's report for October 2015 shows an opening balance at Tomahawk Community Bank of \$66,921.86. October deposits of \$91,381.01 Withdraws of 24,105.73 leaving a ending balance of \$134,197.13. There was a Tomaszewski/Wiese motion to accept into records. All ayes. Motion carried.

-There was a Steigerwaldt/Tomaszewski motion to approve the October 12, 2015 meeting minutes with a couple of small grammar changes. All ayes. Motion carried.

Old Business:

-Fire Calls. One (1) old (from 2014) fire call was collected for \$500.00 and 3 more are being worked on by Supervisor Andy Tomaszewski. There were no new calls in October.

- No new driveway permits were issued in October.

- Chairman reported on his experience at the recent Annual WI Towns Assoc. Convention. He brought back materials for the town employees to review as needed.

-Lund Driveway was discussed. A new driveway has been completed without towns approval. There was a Steigerwaldt/ Tomaszewski motion to send town written letter to Lund's. All Ayes. Motion carried. Supervisor Andy Tomaszewski to contact Attorney Harold.

-Eagle Bay Road: Because previous Board had approved accepting road, indefinitely, in the past, upon which the current board can act to approve with re-application and updated information.

Board requires quit claim deed from all current property owners and requests that the road be re-measured.

There was a Tomaszewski/Wiese motion to accept Eagle Bay Road as a Town road if all documents are in order. All ayes. Motion carried. Town must then file with Lincoln County and the State of Wisconsin required paper work.

New Business:

-Animal Control: Clerk contacted current "Dog Catcher" for the Town of King to make sure he was still interested in working with us. He is and his name is Terry Hager. Contact phone #'s will be sent to all Town Board members. Because there is a charge for his service, options were discussed on how we can recover those charges from the animal's owner.

-At 8:31 pm there was a Wiese/Tomaszewski motion to adjourn. All ayes Motion passed.
