Town Board Meeting

Approved Minutes

Monday December 14, 2015

-Chairman Wiese called the meeting to order at 7:00pm

-Roll call of officers was taken. Chairman Wiese, Supervisors Steigerwaldt & Tomaszewski, Treasurer Julie Allen and Clerk Donna Edwards were present.

-There was a Steigerwaldt/Tomaszewski motion to approve the agendas written. All ayes. Motion passed.

- First Public Forum-brief concerns: Town Resident stated that the road sign on Anglers Avenue was confusing. Resident requested a North Anglers sign to clarify location from Fisherman's Road.

Voucher Approval: There was a Steigerwaldt/Wiese motion to move voucher approval to later in the meeting.

The Treasurer's report for November 2015 shows an opening balance at Tomahawk Community Bank of \$134,197.14. November deposits of \$11,736.38, withdraws of \$12,674.61 leaving an ending balance of \$133,259.01. There was a Steigerwaldt/Wiese motion to accept into records. All ayes. Motion carried.

-There was a Steigerwaldt/Wiese motion to approve the November 9, 2015 meeting minutes with a couple of changes. To correct the spelling of resident's last name and to re-word the section on Eagle Bay Road for clarification purposes. All ayes. Motion carried.

-Correspondence: There were two letters sent to the chairman from the Dept. of Transportation. The first dealing with the TAP cycle application period for 2016-2020. It was determined by the board that this is something that we are not eligible for. Second referred to the completion of a road project on the corner of Hwy. 8 and US 51. The clerk received an e-mail from Lincoln County discussing the proposed changes to the shore land zoning. The clerk was asked to forward this e-mail to town board members along with all other informational e-mails she receives.

Old Business:

-Fire Calls. One (1) old (from 2014) fire call was collected for \$500. Supervisor Tomaszewski felt one more of the 2014 fire calls should be written off, and explained why. There was a motion by Steigerwaldt/Wiese to write off this \$750.00 call due to complications in collections (medical issues). All ayes, motion carried.

- No new driveway permits were issued in November. A letter was sent to one resident after a new driveway was observed. Chairman Wiese will call resident and review with them the towns' "temporary permit ordinance".

-Lund Driveway. There was a Steigerwaldt/Wiese motion to send another copy of the letter sent last month reminding resident that a driveway permit cannot be issued without an easement permit. At a later date, clerk to send out a letter to remind resident of charges due. All Ayes. Motion carried.

-Eagle Bay Road: Chairman received requested paper work on said road, quit claim deed & request to take property out of forestry land. No back taxes are or will be due on this land. This road is now a town road.

New Business:

-Approval of class B liquor/picnic license for Lake Alice Association. There was a Wiese/Tomaszewski motion to approve this one day license for the "Alice in Winterland" fishery in February 2016. All Ayes. Motion carried. A representative from the organization asked the board that if the lake didn't safely freeze over, could they use the boat landing by Anglers Lane. Board approved.

-Appointment of Deputy Clerk in Clerks absence. Due to possible upcoming election, clerk will make other arrangements at this time.

Comments: Chairman Wiese noted that he had contacted a contractor to look at repairs needed on South Pine Road. Work has not yet been completed, and if Chairman Wiese cannot reach contractor in the next couple of days, another contractor will be asked.

Voucher approval-There was a Wiese/Steigerwaldt motion to approve the vouchers. All ayes. Motion carried

-At 8:03pm there was a Wiese/Tomaszewski motion to adjourn. All ayes Motion passed.
