Town Board Meeting

Approved Minutes

Monday March 14, 2016

-Chairman Wiese called the meeting to order at 7:00pm

-The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

-Roll call of officers was taken. Chairman Wiese, Supervisors Steigerwaldt & Tomaszewski, Treasurer Julie Allen and Clerk Donna Edwards were present.

-First public forum – Resident brought up why new signage wasn't placed to identify North Anglers Road. Chairman Wiese assured it would be ordered and placed within a couple of weeks.

-There was a Steigerwaldt/Tomaszewski motion to approve the agenda as written. All ayes. Motion carried.

-Voucher Approval: There was a Steigerwaldt/Wiese motion to approve the vouchers. All ayes. Motion carried.

-The Treasurer's report for February 2016 shows an opening balance at Tomahawk Community Bank of \$925,583.40. February deposits of \$312,541.75, withdraws of \$995,572.52 leaving an ending balance of \$242,552.63. There was a Steigerwaldt/Tomaszewski motion to accept into records. All ayes. Motion carried.

-There was a Steigerwaldt/Tomaszewski motion to approve the February 8, 2016 meeting minutes with 1 correction. All ayes. Motion carried.

-Correspondence: Clerk Edwards read a Thank You note from the Lincoln County Humane Society for our donation. The Annual Fire contract came in the mail that day, and it was \$1000.00+ more than the previous years contract. Clerk was given the approval to call and ask why. A brochure was received concerning the purchase of road signs. Two seminars are upcoming concerning asphalt and blacktopping and A brochure for a seminar concerning unemployment laws.

Old Business:

-Fire Calls. One new fire call received today. Supervisor Tomaszewski received an e-mail saying the City of Tomahawk would credit our account for the \$1000.00 that was determined not to be our responsibility from a previous year. He asked them instead to please send a check. They agreed.

- No new driveway permits were issued in February. The "New" Lund Driveway still not approved by Town Board and Lund payment (check) has not been cashed. Supervisor Tomaszewski will look into and follow through with Lund.

New Business:

Town of King annual meeting: The date was incorrectly stated on the agenda. The correct date is Tuesday, April 19th, 2016 @ 7:00pm.

-Outdoor lighting on garage. There was a Steigerwaldt/Wiese motion to repair outdoor light on garage. All ayes. Motion carried.

-Town Roads-There was a long discussion on 2016 road budget and what work could be done with the budgeted money and which roads should be considered. It was decided that all board members, along with the road superintendent, tour the town roads, get prices together on road improvement materials (gravel, blacktop, chip seal, ect.) and come back to another meeting with pricing and suggestions. The board is looking at possibly adding to the road budget which would require a public meeting. The road budget now stands at just under \$68,000.00 for 2016. Board wants more information from road superintendent before any projects are scheduled.

-Comments: Chairman Wiese was approached by a town resident with concerns about the heat loss in the town hall building. The resident (who is a licensed contractor) volunteered to do the labor to repair the heat loss, showing on roof, for free. Supervisor Steigerwaldt said this had been looked at in the past and much of the heat loss there is from no insulation in the hall walls, but did think it was a good idea to look at it again.

-At 8:50pm there was a Wiese/Tomaszewski motion to adjourn. All ayes. Motion passed.
