Town Board Meeting

Approved Minutes

Monday May 9, 2016

- Chairman Wiese called the meeting to order at 7:02pm
- The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- Roll call of officers was taken. Chairman Wiese, Supervisors Steigerwaldt & Tomaszewski, Treasurer Julie Allen and Clerk Donna Edwards were present.
- First public forum – A resident on North Anglers Road said the new sign is still not up identifying the road. The road superintendent assured the resident the sign has been ordered.
- There was a Steigerwaldt/Tomaszewski motion to approve the agenda as written. All ayes. Motion carried.
- Voucher Approval: There was a Wiese/Steigerwaldt motion to approve the vouchers. All ayes. Motion carried.
- The Treasurer's report for April 2016 shows an opening balance at Tomahawk Community Bank of \$198,771.52. April deposits of \$21,286.70, withdraws of \$30,509.49 leaving an ending balance of \$189,548.73. There was a Wiese/Steigerwaldt motion to accept Treasurer's report as written into records. All ayes. Motion carried.
- There was a Steigerwaldt/Tomaszewski motion to approve the April 11, 2016 meeting minutes with 3 additions or corrections. All ayes. Motion carried.
- Correspondence: Clerk Edwards read: A request was received from WPS asking for our road work schedule for 2016. They would like to work with us, if at all possible, when major road projects are being done.
- Lincoln County sent the Town a copy of their "Shoreline Ordinance" with the recent changes. This will be available in the clerks office.
- A pricing list was received from WI Salt Solutions for further reference.

Old Business:

- Fire Calls: No new fire calls were received this month. Supervisor Tomaszewski told the board he was working on receiving reimbursement for another "old" fire call.
- Driveway Permits: The town road superintendent sent a letter to a logging company about their recently installed driveway without first getting a permit.
- Recycling Service Agreement- Chairman Wiese is in the process of setting up a meeting with Advanced Disposal Co. to review current contract. Supervisor Steigerwaldt is looking into other recycling companies that we can possibly negotiate a contract with. The clerk was directed to look into costs and tonnage from previous years to determine any differences.
- Lund driveway-An e-mail was sent to the towns e-mail account from Holly Lund requesting many documents from the towns records in relation to her open driveway issue with the town. Supervisor Tomaszewski and the clerk gathered all the material she requested (this is not the first time this has been done), then a letter was put together and with boards approval, will be sent to her this week.
- Town Roads: The town board rescheduled touring town roads for either Wed., May 19 or Thurs, May 20.
- Update on Broadband/High speed internet for the town of King: Treasurer Allen did not have any updates to report, but assured the town board and residents she would share all information pertaining to our Township.

New Business:

- Boat Landing: A list of our 5 boat landings will be submitted to North Central WI-Regional Planning Commission for consideration for grant money. They are located on N. Birch Road, Horseshoe, Anglers, Sandy Lane and Shorewood.
- Taves conditional use request- With no objections the board voted unanimously to recommend allowing this request, with no conditions, to the Lincoln County Land Services Committee. There was a Wiese/Steigerwaldt motion to recommend approving this conditional use permit with no conditions to Lincoln co. All ayes. Motion Carried.

-Open Book and Board of Review- Scheduled for Saturday, June 4th, 2016 Open Book from 8:00am to 10:00am and Board Review to follow from 10:00am – 12:00 noon.

-Billing for Snow Plowing private roads for 2015-2016 season. Board reviewed invoices to be sent to representatives of each private road and approved. There was a Tomaszewski/Wiese motion to send invoices as written. All ayes. Motion Carried
