

Town of King Town Board Meeting

Approved Minutes

Monday July 11, 2016

-Chairman Wiese called the meeting to order at 7:00pm

-The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

-Roll call of officers was taken. Chairman Wiese, Supervisors Steigerwaldt & Tomaszewski, Treasurer Julie Allen and Clerk Donna Edwards were present.

-First public forum – A town resident who lives on N. Birch Road addressed the board with concerns of neighbors setting off large fireworks displays during all hours of the day and night and the frequency of the disturbance(not just on the 4th of July). Chairman Wiese will do some checking into what can, if anything, be done to limit this concern.

-There was a Tomaszewski/Wiese motion to approve the agenda as written. All ayes. Motion carried.

-Voucher Approval: There was a Wiese/Tomaszewski motion to approve the vouchers. All ayes. Motion carried.

-The Treasurer's report for June 2016 shows an opening balance at Tomahawk Community Bank of \$182,469.34. June deposits of \$19,364.45, withdraws of \$9,803.24 leaving an ending balance of \$192,030.55. There was a Wiese/Steigerwaldt motion to accept into records. All ayes. Motion carried.

-There was a Wiese/Steigerwaldt motion to approve the June 13, 2016 meeting minutes with 2 revisions. All ayes. Motion carried.

-Correspondence: Clerk Edwards received an E-mail from Lincoln County in reference to an upcoming public meeting on the Shoreland Ordinance on July 14, 2016. Chairman Wiese received a letter from the State with revised numbers for our TRIP Road Request (an increase to us by \$330.04). Chairman Wiese received a card from the WTA that the next meeting is at 7:00pm on July 21, 2016 at Rock Falls.

Old Business:

-Fire calls: There was one new fire call this month. Letter has been sent to accident victim and a copy given to Supervisor Tomaszewski.

-Driveway permits-There was ~~on~~no new driveway permit issued this month.

-Recycling: There was a Steigerwaldt/Wiese motion to continue with our current recycling company, Advanced Disposal, on our month to month basis. All Ayes. Motion carried. Road Superintendent, Jagmin will meet with rep. of Advanced with an updated "pick-up" schedule. He was asked by Chairman Wiese to remind them that the dumpsters must be locked before they leave.

-Update on Broadband/High Speed internet for the town of King. There was some discussion about the new fiber optic line that was going in along Hwy. A. It was noted that Treehaven and Case had contracted with Charter Business to install the High Speed line to their facilities. It was suggested that the Town of King needs to adopt a policy or ordinance for utilities to do work affecting our town roads. Supervisor Steigerwaldt will check with the Town of Bradley Chairman to see if they have a policy/ordinance and if they would share it with us. Item to be on next months agenda.

New Business:

-Replacement of sand spreader on plow truck: Superintendent Jagmin provided the board with preliminary amounts to replace just the auger, \$558.00 material + \$500.00 for labor. To replace the spinner spreader, the cost would be \$3500.00(ish) for a ~~medal~~ metal unit or \$4100.00(ish) for stainless steel. The board directed superintendent Jagmin to get firmer prices by next months meeting.

-Grading Northforest Road: Clerk Edwards to send E-mail to Town's Association to ask about towns legal ability to grade town roads.

-Private road sign on Eagle Bay Road. Superintendent Jagmin was directed by the board to remove the sign.

-WI Towns Assoc.-Annual Convention (Sunday 10/09 thru Tuesday 10/11). Supervisor Steigerwaldt indicated that he would be attending this year. Because he has family in the area, he will not incur lodging costs.

-Comments: Because mowing and shouldering was not on this months agenda, must be on next months.
-Adjourn: Chairman Wiese made a motion to adjourn at 8:10pm. All Ayes. Motion carried.
