Town Board Meeting

Approved Minutes

Monday August 8, 2016

-Chairman Wiese called the meeting to order at 7:00pm

-The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

-Roll call of officers was taken. Chairman Wiese, Supervisors Steigerwaldt & Tomaszewski, Treasurer Julie Allen and Clerk Donna Edwards were present.

-First public forum – None

-There was a Steigerwaldt/Wiese motion to make changes to the agenda by moving the land use items 1 & 2, of new business up to right after correspondence. All ayes. Motion carried.

-Voucher Approval: Supervisor Steigerwaldt questioned if a check had been written for grading on NorthForest road. He was told no, and that it was an item later on the agenda. He then expressed some concern with the checks written to Superior Sealing Service and Lincoln County. He was aware that the shouldering was not complete on Eagle Point Road which was part of the Lincoln County Highway check. Road Superintendent, Jagmin assured him the shouldering work would be completed at a later date and we would be billed for it at that time. Supervisor Steigerwaldt then expressed a concern with the crack sealing that had been done and made the motion to approve the vouchers with the exception of Superior Crack Sealing, pending a later discussion and possible approval at that time. Wiese seconded the motion. All ayes. Motion carried.

Supervisor Steigerwaldt then requested that two outstanding payroll checks that had been issued to him in 2015 be voided and reissued because they were lost. The clerk said she would have to contact the accountant before doing so.

-The Treasurer's report for July 2016 shows an opening balance at Tomahawk Community Bank of \$192,030.55. July deposits of \$26,522.89, withdraws of \$23,214.48 leaving an ending balance of \$210,815.28. There was a Tomaszewski/Wiese motion to accept into records. All ayes. Motion carried.

-There was a Wiese/Steigerwaldt motion to approve the June 13, 2016 meeting minutes with 2 revisions. All ayes. Motion carried.

-Correspondence: Clerk Edwards received an E-mail from a town resident inquiring about the fiber optic high speed line going in along Hwy. A, and if it would soon be available to residents. The clerk called the project ~~co-~~ coordinator and was told they would like a list of town residents that are interested in the high speed internet service. It was suggested that at the November, Presidential Election, to make a sign-up sheet available.

New Business:

-Conditional Use Permit for Wagner-After a long discussion and comments from town residents on both sides of this issue, there was a Wiese/Steigerwaldt motion to make No Recommendation to the County Board do to opposing points from town residents. All ayes. Motion carried.

-Land use change for Williams/Davis-After some discussion there was a Steigerwaldt/Wiese motion to recommend to Lincoln County, the transfer of this property from residential to recreational. All ayes. Motion carried.

Old Business:

-Fire calls: There were no new fire call this month. Supervisor Tomaszewski followed through with the collection of one call. The insurance company sent a check for \$500.00 and the resident also sent a check for the entire amount of \$750.00. If both checks go through, a check for \$500.00 will need to be issued back to the resident.

-Driveway permits-There were no new driveway permits issued this month. Per Chairman Wiese, a new driveway has been installed on the corner of Spring Creek Rd. and Mountain Rd. This is the same property owner that had an additional 5 or 6 temporary driveways installed last year, and no driveway permits were applied for or given. Chairman Wiese will follow-up.

- Recycling: Photographs of people dumping stuff in the locked recycle dumpsters were taken. Supervisor Tomaszewski to follow-up.
  - Update on Broadband/High Speed internet for the town of King. This was discussed earlier in the meeting.
  - Grading North Forest Road: Table item to next month's meeting. Chairman Wiese to contact former town supervisor for information regarding that road and town's boat landing.
  - New Business:
  - Mowing-Chairman Wiese to contact mowing contractor for areas missed in the township during the roadside mowing process.
  - Burying Utilities- Supervisor Steigerwaldt has contacted a board member from another township to review their ordinance on this issue. Hold over to next month's meeting.
  - Anglers Avenue- Chairman Wiese apologized to residents of the area. He did not know the extent of the storm damage and it took longer to start the clean-up than it could have.
  - Emergency Plan for Storm Damage, ect.- Town to develop policy including a chain of command for emergencies.
  - Boat landing signage-It was determined that Road Closed signs were adequate for closing a boat landing.
  - North Twin Lake Road-Resident concerned with run off going through his property. Supervisor Steigerwaldt to review survey maps for that area.
  - Lincoln County Ordinance Text Amendment- To change size requirements on out buildings. There was a Steigerwaldt/Wiese motion to have the chairman sign the Lincoln County Ordinance Text Amendment. All ayes. Motion carried.
  - Comments: any items not requiring board action; agenda items for next month's meeting-Employee stated that more trash was accumulating on Shady Shore East. It was noted that possibly, it was coming from a recently sold cabin in the area.
- Town employee thanked the board for purchasing a pressure washer. It made clean-up of shop and equipment much easier.
- Replacement of sand spreader on plow truck: Superintendent Jagmin provided the board with quotes to replace the spinner spreader on the plow truck. The board will review at next month's meeting.
  - Superior Crack Sealing-Supervisor Steigerwaldt expressed concerns with the crack sealing that was done on town roads. After reviewing some of the sealing, he was concerned that no leveling appeared to have been done. Also, the pebbles covering the crack sealing were washing off onto the shoulders. There was a Wiese/Tomaszewski motion to approve sending out the check to Superior Crack Sealing. Wiese and Tomaszewski, ayes. Steigerwaldt, Nay. The ayes carried.
  - Adjourn: There was a Wiese /Tomaszewski motion to adjourn at 8:58pm. All Ayes. Motion carried.
