

Town of King Town Board Meeting

Approved Minutes

Monday November 14, 2016

- Chairman Wiese called the meeting to order at 7:17pm
- Roll call of officers was taken. Chairman Wiese, Supervisors Steigerwaldt & Tomaszewski, Treasurer Julie Allen and Clerk Donna Edwards were present.
- First public forum –Supervisor Steigerwaldt said they hoped to have the insulation work done in the attic within the next two weeks. Road Superintendent told the board that there were still 2 leaks in the garage roof after work had been completed. Clerk Edwards commented on the town’s turnout of the 2016 Presidential election. The Town of King has 661 registered voters of which 616 votes were casted.
- Agenda-There was a Wiese/Tomaszewski motion to approve the agenda. All ayes. Motion carried.
- Voucher Approval: There was a Steigerwaldt/Wiese motion to approve the vouchers. All ayes. Motion carried
- The Treasurer’s report for October 2016 shows an opening balance at Tomahawk Community Bank of \$232,615.49. October deposits of \$23,658.94, withdraws of \$57,700.89, leaving an ending balance of \$198,573.54. There was a Tomaszewski/Steigerwaldt motion to accept into records. All ayes. Motion carried.
- Minute’s approval-There was a Steigerwaldt/Wiese motion to approve the October 10, 2016 meeting minutes with 2 spelling corrections and one clarification revision. All ayes. Motion carried.
- Correspondence: Clerk Edwards received a mailing from the DNR. An order of designation for 89.71 acres of land near Red Arrow will be deemed managed forest land as of 01/01/2017. Treasurer Allen received a letter from the DNR stating that the Town of King would be receiving a total of \$5641.46 for recent changes in their reimbursement program. Chairman Wiese received a letter for Lincoln County Land Services stating the approval of the Jason and Christina Davis property land use change with recommendations. He received an E-mail from an informed town resident stating that the fiber optic cable to the cell tower on Highway D will be completed before Thanksgiving and should be functioning by Christmas.

Old Business:

- Fire calls: (1) one new fire call. Person has been contacted and a bill has been sent.
- Driveway permits-There were no new driveway permits.
- Recycling: Place signage “under camera surveillance” near recycling area.

New Business:

- Review of Private Roads snow plowing contracts: Chairman Wiese signed all 2016-2017, previously board approved, snow plowing contracts and clerk will mail.
 - Grounds improvement: Supervisor Steigerwaldt will bring a cut Christmas tree and would like to have it decorated with blue lights. Next year he will plant a tree for this purpose. He also suggested that work be done on the outside of the building to encourage drainage away from the basement walls.
 - CDL random drug testing: Per Town of Bradley chairman, Kevin Koth and Town’s Association Attorney, all towns are covered through the state, and no additional contracts are needed.
 - Approval of 2017 budget: There was a Steigerwaldt/Wiese motion to accept the budget summary as recorded at the Town of King special budget meeting of the electors. All ayes. Motion carried.
 - Downed trees on Anglers Avenue: Superintendent Jagmin will contact residents on Anglers Avenue to make sure none of them want the downed trees in the towns right away. If no property owners want the wood, Jagmin can make arrangements to get rid of it.
 - Permit for vendors doing work that may affect town roads: Supervisor Tomaszewski suggested that a possible “Non charge permit” be required for contractors before doing any “heavy” work in the township. This would allow a town employee to review the road condition before and after the work was complete. Board will look into.
 - Comments: Supervisor Steigerwaldt suggested that the 2016 tax insert include notice to town residents that plowing snow in the early spring and late fall is not done due to the damage it will cause to roads.
 - Adjourn: There was a Wiese /Tomaszewski motion to adjourn at 8:30pm. All Ayes. Motion carried.
